

Gross Vehicle Mass (GVM):

GVM

The maximum weight a vehicle is permitted to attain.



- The manufacturer determines the **GVM**
- Each axle is designed to carry a specific weight
- The **GVM** is stamped on the compliance plate and appears on registration papers.

TARE Weight

The truck's unloaded weight.
Fuel included.



Other terms used to describe TARE Weight are Unladen Mass, Unladen State, Unladen Weight and Empty Weight. You can find TARE Weight on registration papers.

Carrying Capacity

The maximum load weight a truck can carry.
